LoveEd is a brand new program that helps empower parents to teach both the theology and science of human sexuality within the context of God's plan for love and life.

LoveEd is a parent-guided, age-appropriate, gender-specific program that teaches children about God's plan for life, love, sexuality, and purity. It equips parents to have positive, life-changing conversations with their kids. It facilitates these conversations at two important life transitions: as they enter puberty (Level I-grade 5 or 6) and just before they begin high school (Level II-grade 7 or 8).
